1. Purpose of Survey

This survey aims to study the employment status of the technical intern trainees who returned to their home countries in FY 2021 (hereinafter referred to as "former trainees"), job/skill transfer support and acquisitions of skills, etc. during the technical intern training through the supervising organizations and implementing organizations of individual enterprise-type training (hereinafter referred to as "supervising organizations").

2. Survey target

Supervising Organizations, etc.

3. Survey method

- 1)Send survey forms and online response manuals to survey subjects.
- 2) Survey subject answers the questionnaire and return it to OTIT survey office or respond online.
- 3) Multiple choice and free description.

4. Number of valid answers and response rate

Responses received between September 1 and November 30, 2022.

Cooperation status with the sending organization

In relation to the survey on situations of former technical intern trainees after returning to home countries, the number of sending organizations keeping a cooperative relationship with supervising organizations was 5,424.



Regarding the number of sending organizations which keep a cooperative relationship with supervising organizations, the largest number of supervising organizations answered that they were 2-3 organizations, accounting for 31.0%.




Employment status of former trainees after returning to home countries

In regards to the employment status after returning to their home countries, 51.6% of the total respondents answered either "employed and working" (40.7%), "started own business" (5.9%), or "employed and scheduled to work" (5.0%). (N=52,164; FY2022)




55.7% of the former trainees responded that their specific job duties are "same as training" (31.1%) or "same as type of job duties as the training" (24.6%) (N=26,596; FY2022)

Assistance status for promoting skill transfer of former trainees


73.2% of the supervising organizations answered that they provided assistance for promoting skill transfer of former trainees (including cooperative relationship and assistance to sending organizations). (N=1,773; FY2022)



Specific support details

As for the specific details, "Issuance of Certificate of Completion of Technical Intern Training, Certificate of Employment, etc. in Japan" was the most common at 81.0%, "Consultations regarding employment and entrepreneurship after returning to home countries" was 36.2%, "Information and recommendation of employment after returning home countries" followed by 32.5%.

Currently, 98.6% of the supervising organizations answered that they are proceeding according to the Technical Intern Training Plan regarding technical intern trainees residing in Japan. (N=2,408; FY2022)
