

To avoid getting involved in crime

In recent years, criminal organizations have been using informations in the internet of the home country of the technical intern trainees, SNS job advertisements, solicitations from friends and acquaintances, etc., and to sweet talk them for job placements and arranged disappearances. There are some cases where technical interns are involved in various crimes.

To work other than technical intern training, part-time job, or disappearing from the implementing company to perform another job.

Violation of the Immigration Control Act by engaging in activities other than those permitted (illegal work)



Transferring or selling to another person the bank account, passbook, atm card, or mobile phone that you have been using until now, just because you are returning home.

Pretend to be another person and sign a delivery slip, and take another person's delivery goods.

Do not take part in criminal activities that are lurking around you !

These jobs, while ostensibly simple and appears to be with favorable conditions such as high pay or instant pay, are all **criminal acts**.

As criminal organization skillfully recruits technical intern trainees, in some cases, they may go on doing things without being aware that their behavior is a crime.

Even if technical intern trainees were used in this way by a criminal organization, they would be arrested by the police as a **criminal for participating in criminal acts**. Primarily, you should have acquired skills and returned home safe to your family, however, you would not be able to achieve that purpose, and the disadvantage is that you will be subject to **forced deportation**, etc.

Be careful not to get involved in such crimes.
