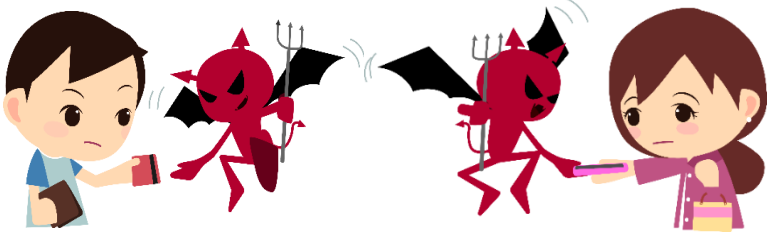


Be prepared not to get involved in a crime

Recently, there have been incidents in which crime syndicates lured foreigners into committing various kinds of criminal acts, by posting information on websites or job ads on social media intended for people of the countries where the syndicates are based, or approaching the trainees via their friends and acquaintances. The following are examples of such criminal acts. Please be careful not to get involved in these criminal acts, and contact the police if you notice any sign or attempt of criminal acts involving technical intern trainees.

STOP !



Transferring or selling to another person your bankbook, cash card and mobile phone.



Receiving a parcel addressed to another person



Acquiring cash or a cash card in the guise of another person, or withdrawing cash using another person's cash card

Acts that qualify as crime	Applicable crimes
Providing or acquiring, for free or for value, passbooks or cash cards for bank accounts, or account information used for funds transfer or crypto-asset exchange services	Act on Prevention of Transfer of Criminal Proceeds
Giving away your mobile phone to another person	Violation of the Mobile Phone Improper Use Prevention Act
Receiving cash or a cash card in the guise of another person (collecting money through a scam)	Fraud
Withdrawing cash from another person's bank account at an ATM using such other person's cash card (withdrawing money through a scam)	Theft
Receiving a parcel addressed to another person	Counterfeiting of a private seal
Gambling	Gambling
